Maximum weights: LW1x: 59 kg and LM1x: 72,5 kg
Minimum weight for coxswain: 55 kg



Entry fee

In principle, no entry fee will be charged if the hotel bookings for the registering nations are made through the RVLO as the organizer. If this is not the case, a flat-rate entry fee of € 150,-- will be charged per accredited person.

Late entries

In principle, these are not possible.

Junior Licenses

Austrian youth rowers are only eligible to start if they have a valid junior license by the registration deadline. In addition, the usual Austrian regulations apply.

Race Clothing

The race clothing is the respective national jersey. All other clothing must be uniform.

Safety

The Regatta course will be secured during the races with the help of motorboats.

A Red Cross team and a doctor will also be on site during the race times.

Free practice takes place at your own risk.

Liability

The organizer is liable in accordance with legal regulations. Insurance of equipment and persons is the responsibility of the participants. The organizer assumes no liability for damages in this regard of any kind.

10. Permission by registering, the registering association grants permission for the publication of start lists and results, including names and photos, for the individuals registered by it.
11. Approval by the ÖRV Technical Commission on March 22, 2025, regarding conformity to the ÖRV rules and any deviations therefrom. The organizing association is responsible for compliance with all other (including official) regulations.
